



Zephyrhills High School alumni, teachers and friends enjoyed their annual summer blast from the past on Sunday with some folks travelling from across the country.

The reunion is held every year on the last Sunday of June at the Zephyrhills Lions Club and includes non- alumni who may have any kind of connection with the school.

"The biggest thing about this reunion as opposed to a class reunion is you get to see people from all the years," said Jerry Pricher (Class of 1969), president of the ZHS reunion committee. "My brother graduated in 1954; I will see his classmates and I'll see my classmates from 1969. We're all in the same room and we all know each other. You know, it's a small community."

The get-together began at 11 a.m., when guests were able to mix, mingle and catch up with others for a couple of hours before a buffet was spread out.

Mayor Gene Whitfield led the room in the Pledge of Allegiance, and a short prayer followed. A moment of silence was shared in remembrance of lost classmates in the past year.

Everyone brought a covered dish to share, and with more than 200 in attendance it was a feast for the eyes and stomach.

Fried chicken, biscuits, green beans, casseroles and not to mention two flanking dessert tables took over one side of the hall.

On the other side of the room, another two rows of tables were covered with yearbooks, scrapbooks and poster boards all containing pictures from the past. Guests moseyed through the memorabilia throughout the afternoon, smiling with the turn of each page.

Bill Baker graduated from ZHS in 1954 and began teaching in Zephyrhills in 1959 after finishing college. Now living in Atlanta, he makes the eight-hour drive every year to visit his friends and hometown.

"It brings a lot of memories back. My favorite years [teaching] were here in Zephyrhills," he said. "It's just something I look forward to every year."

At 2 p.m., Pricher announced Delaney Copeland from the class of 2016 as the winner of the ZHS CAPS Scholarship. Alexandra Harwell and Felicia Riggs were also recognized as the winners of the Rosemary Trottman award.

Bob Winters (1965) won the 50/50 raffle with a prize of over \$300, which he donated back to the reunion association.

Pricher went on to recognize those in attendance.

The King Family was recognized for having the most family members at the reunion, with a total of 13.

Bernice (Curtis) Rooks (1940) was the oldest graduate in attendance this year, and Casey Harrison (2016) was the youngest.

JoAnn (Hile) Randall (1972) was recognized for travelling the farthest to attend this year's celebration – 3,000 miles from Salem, Oregon.

The annual reunions have been around since the late '70s, and Pricher said there are always a couple of people each year who travel from the west coast to visit their alma mater.

"I think people who grew up here tend to keep their roots. They don't forget where they grew up. They may move away, but they don't forget where they came from. It's a close-knit community in that way," Pricher said.

The Treasurer's report was given by Treasurer Clereen Brunty with motion to accept by Bill Kustes, seconded by Tenci Alexander and approved.

Old Business: Regarding fundraisers, Patty Thompson distributed flyers for the next event which will be at Mike's Smokehouse on July 26. Since there was only \$20 from the May fundraiser at Mike's, it will be added to the amount with the July event. The Rosemary Trottman Scholarship Fundraiser for June was held at Sergio's Italian Restaurant and garnered \$82.22.
