





# Business Meeting Minutes March 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019

The Regular Monthly Business Meeting of the Zephyrhills Historical Association was called to order at 5:30 P.M. by President Jerry Pricher, who gave the Invocation and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The minutes from the February meeting were read by the Secretary and amended, as Beverly Holmes pointed out that participation in the Golf Tournament should read "\$40 to sponsor a hole" rather than \$45. Rod Rehrig made a motion to approve the amended minutes, seconded by Clereen Brunty and agreed to by the group.

The Treasurer's Report for February was given by Andrew Nagy. A motion to accept the Report was made by Beverly, seconded by Clereen and agreed to by all.

New member, Joe Radecki, introduced himself. He lives here 6 months and in Minneapolis the other 6 months.

Old Business: Fundraisers - Patty Thompson brought in flyers for the March 19, Rosemary Trottman Scholarship Fundraiser at Sergio's.
